On March 16, 2018, Mediapart will be ten years old. A decade of fighting for a free press, serving the public's right to know. Ten years to impose a paid model that, until then, had never been tried on the Net for the daily press of political and general information. Ten years to convince us that our job, journalism, was not condemned to precariousness, social plans, cascading buyouts, loss of independence and vitality, declining quality and the race for money. audience, but that it could be economically profitable in the requirement, create value and jobs in independence. That he could make a press business profitable by keeping it free from any pressure, be it economic or political, financial or state, advertising or partisan.

But the greatest happiness was to meet an audience, that is to say all of you: loyal readers, passionate, critical, free to admonish us or encourage us, to argue or to alert us, to show us or to jostle us.

Diary born of the digital revolution, Mediapart would never have succeeded without the participatory dimension that bears his name: a media apart, but above all a participatory media. No newspaper of political and general information on the Net maintains today the particular relation that reigns here, not without snags sometimes like the very life, that it is in the Club or in the threads of comments: a diversity of opinions and a plurality of sensibilities that are as rich in the sparks they produce.

In short, the virtual is real, and this is what we want to celebrate at this tenth anniversary, organized on the theme of the meeting of journalism and society. Rather than give in to self-congratulation when speaking of Mediapart, we preferred to celebrate together all that has come together, crossed, experienced, sought, found, invented, expressed, defended, etc., in this crossroads that our newspaper.
